Academic Updates TLA

This month, we will continue to develop our five paragraph informational writing skills. We will practice finding information from multiple sources to use as supporting evidence in our written expression. We will focus on transition words and learn to combine sentences for more formal writing.

In grammar, we will concentrate on using correlative conjunctions and review prepositions. Students should remember to complete their two Reading Plus reading lessons each week to 80% or higher.

Science

This month, we will begin the Life Science standard S5L1. In this standard, students will obtain, evaluate, and communicate information to group organisms using scientific classification procedures. They will develop a model that illustrates how animals are sorted into groups (vertebrate and invertebrate) and how vertebrates are sorted into groups (fish, amphibian, reptile, bird, and mammal) using data from multiple sources. Students will also develop a model that illustrates how plants are sorted into groups (seed producers, non-seed producers) using data from multiple sources.
