ELA

What a great group of readers and writers we have this year in 5th grade! We are so excited to work with your child! Our focus for Unit 1 in Reading will be finding an informational text's main idea. Your students will be able to explain how two or more central ideas are supported by key details in a text. They will also be able to draw evidence to support their text analysis through written responses (CSET). In addition to reading, we are focusing on parts of speech and comma rules. Our word study includes learning to recognize and use different letter patterns for the same sound to make students' reading more efficient and spelling more accurate. Please encourage your students to read their library books for 20 minutes each day. We appreciate your support and encouragement!
