

The mission of Jasper Middle School is to educate all students in a safe environment and to empower all to be life long learners and productive citizens.


VALUES At JMS We Believe:

JMS Before-School Car Drop-off

- 7:30 am 7:50 am
- Students are dropped off at the staircase leading from the school-side sidewalk on Stegall Drive to the JMS gym.
- Look for flashing lights in SRO vehicle
 this is where you drop off students
 between 7:30 am and 7:50 am.





JMS Morning Car Drop-off

- 7:50 am 8:30 am
- Students are dropped at the front entrance of JMS.
- Unlike elementary schools, once your vehicle is stopped, your child may exit onto the sidewalk on Stegall Drive nearest the school. Once your child has exited, and it is safe to do so, you may proceed into the traffic lane of Stegall Drive (you do not have to wait for clearance from staff or SRO.



JMS Afternoon Car Pick-up

- 3:30 pm 4:00 pm
- Students will dismiss from the gym, exiting the gym stairs
- Cars line up in the parking spaces on the far right, and the right-hand lane of traffic on Stegall Drive, leaving two lanes for cars to be loaded, with the far left lane of the street clear for traffic (this lane must remain open).
- JMS Staff will call kids from the gym, and cars in both lanes will be loaded from the gym stairs to the crosswalk at the entrance of the school.
- Once both lanes are loaded, the SRO or JMS staff will release both lanes of traffic. Please wait until directed to drive away in the afternoon car lanes.

JMS Bus Drop-off and Pick-off

- The buses will drop-off and pick-up at the rear of JMS, off Sanders Street.
- JMS kids share buses with the elementary schools, so our students are the oldest, and need to set a positive example.
- There are two loads of afternoon bus riders: first load will dismiss to the bus, and second load will dismiss to the cafeteria until their bus arrives.







Recess

- At JMS, all kids will have recess daily (weather permitting).
- We have multiple playground areas, and activities for students.

JMS Before-School and After-School Programs

- JMS offers before-school program from <u>7:30 until 7:50</u> each day. This is free of charge.
- JMS offers after-school program from <u>3:30 until 6:00</u> each day. There is a charge of \$7 per day for this program, which also includes snack.

Classes at JMS Academic

- Students will have 4 academic classes each day
 math, reading, science, and social studies
- Math and reading will be 85 minutes each; science and social studies will be 42 minutes each
- In addition to these classes, students will have a 15 minute Morning Meeting during homeroom, and a 30 minute Thinking Maps block.
- Students will have 2 connections classes each day, each lasting 35 minutes

Classes at JMS Connections

- Students will have 2 connections classes each day
- Connection classes will be for a 9 week term, meaning that students will have those classes every day for 9 weeks
- The schedule will be structured so that all students will experience all connections throughout the year (unless in a yearlong course)
- Chorus and Band are yearlong classes, so students in those programs will have those classes each day. Chorus is offered in 5th and 6th grade. Band is only offered in 6th grade.
- Connections classes are JMS are: PE, art, general music, computer lab, agriculture, chorus, band, math connection (all students will participate)

Visiting and Volunteer Opportunities

- All JMS students must be dropped off in the car line. Please know we will have multiple staff members on hand to help your child to class on the first day of school. Please say your goodbyes as you drop your child off in the carline or meet the bus at the bus stop. Thank you for helping us ensure the safety of all children.
- Parents may visit the school at this time to have lunch with students. You must show photo ID, be on approved lists, and sit with your child only in a designated area of the cafeteria or school.
- Volunteer opportunities arise at JMS, and will be shared as they do. Volunteers must complete the volunteer training. Training dates will be shared.


