### Academic Updates

**ELA** - We are enjoying getting to know your students and we are looking forward to a great school year. During the month of August, our ELA classes will begin by reviewing plot elements. We will be watching a series of Pixar short films and reading short stories to learn how to analyze the storyline in order to complete plot diagrams. This will prepare us for our choice reading and our class novel! Once we finish our review of plot elements, we will dive into our Informational Unit. Classes will be reading Zane and the Hurricane or The Cay, and we will be learning about the importance of credible sources in preparation for a short research project that will take place later on in the unit. We will be doing lots of reading and taking several trips to the media center, as well! We encourage our students to read their library books for at least 15 minutes daily. Mini lessons containing grammar and vocabulary will be incorporated throughout every unit.

Unit 1 will introduce students to the study of statistics by experiencing how to design simple experiments and collect data. The unit begins with identifying what constitutes a statistical question. Students can collect, analyze and display data through a number of graphical representations.

Please remember that students have their spiral review to work on each night. Students receive the weekly review on Friday for the following week from their homeroom teacher. Many students are completing this during homeroom but please check with them to make sure it is completed before they come to school.

The spiral review is designed to review those skills that have been covered so students maintain an understanding throughout the school year.
