Science

In Science, we are wrapping up Standard S5P1: physical and chemical changes; and states of water. When we return from Spring Break, we will spend the remainder of April preparing for the Milestones. The science Milestones will be on May 1st. To prepare for it, we will do a spiral review of earth science, life science, and physical science, with a greater emphasis on life science and physical science (the largest makeup of the science Milestones). Students will start to see Milestones practice questions in Progress Learning, as well as participate in the Milestones practice questions offered by the Georgia Dept. of Education.
