Academic Updates

ELA – Sixth-grade students are beginning the narrative unit for Language Arts. In this unit, we read and analyze literary texts while focusing on theme, characterization, plot, conflict, and making inferences. We will focus on constructed responses and writing narratives for our writing standards. In class, students will be reading a variety of short stories and their choice books. Please remember all students should aim to read for 20 minutes each weeknight. Classes will also be finishing the novels Zane and the Hurricane or The Cay.

Mini lessons containing grammar and vocabulary will be incorporated throughout every unit.

Please remind students to complete their Daily ELA Practice each week. They are given time in homeroom daily to complete the questions. If they cannot complete them during homeroom then they will need to finish them for homework. Our morning work typically consists of a short passage and two questions.

In the upcoming unit 3, students will use computational skills (focusing on fractions) to solve problems in context. Students make connections to the classroom beyond the school day when they explore unit rate, ratios, and calculate percentages using proportional reasoning.

Please remember that students have their spiral review to work on each night. Students receive the weekly review on Monday for the following week from their homeroom teacher. Many students are completing this during homeroom but please check with them to make sure it is completed before they come to school.

The spiral review is designed to review those skills that have been covered so students maintain an understanding throughout the school year.

Finding Programs:

At JMS, our students use many great online programs to enhance and reinforce their learning experience (Reading Plus, Newsela, CommonLit, IXL, Canvas, etc.). All of these programs are accessible through Clever. When students log in on their school Chromebooks, the program automatically directs them to Clever. Once they are logged in, they can access all programs without the use of an additional login.

Science - We are wrapping up our unit on the solar system as we learn about small bodies like asteroids, meteoroids, etc... We will have the unit test next week and then move into our unit on the Earth, moon, and sun system. There we will learn about eclipses, seasons, and tides.

We have also begun our science fair. We are doing a class project for those that are not doing the individual projects.
